PROPOSED CHIILA ESTATES PROJECT SOILS INVESTIGATION ATTENTION: TSUUT'INA NATION COMMUNITY



As per the Directive approved by Chief and Minor Chiefs, the Chilla Estates concept seeks to facilitate the creation of a new inclusive community that provides desirable long term housing options and lifestyle amenities for the Tsuut'ina Nation citizens. The conceptual design prioritizes the introduction of a diversity of housing forms to help address the current housing crisis and accommodate the ongoing growth of the Nation. The concept involves a variety of complimenting uses including natural areas/open spaces, community gathering/cultural lands, and civic uses.

As part of the Feasibility Study for the Proposed Chiila Estates Project, our geotechnical consultant (Englobe) is going to be onsite from Monday November 25th to November 29th including December 2nd to drill 40 boreholes and collect soil samples in support of the engineering design. The borehole plan above shows the location of the proposed 40 boreholes.
