Smoke Alarm Assessments and Installations

On July 23, 2025, Tsuut'ina Nation Fire Department, Calgary Fire Department and Kidde created a partnership to promote home safety. Kidde donated battery operated smoke alarms to help ensure as many homes as possible on the Nation have working smoke alarms in case of an emergency.

Beginning August 18, 2025, Tsuut'ina Nation Fire Department will be going door to door to conduct smoke alarm inspections. If needed, crews will install battery operated smoke alarms. Home safety information will be provided to each home. Crews will start on the east end of the nation (146 avenue included) and make their way west.

Our goal is to have all homes assessed by October 3, 2025.
