Proposed Project: Access to Tsuut'ina Nation Lands Via Helicopter to Complete Annual Cathodic Surveys

NGTL Limited Partnership (NGTL) a wholly owned subsidiary of TC Energy Corporation (TC Energy), would like to inform you of proposed maintenance work taking place on Tsuut'ina Nation lands.

NGTL plans to access the right-of-way via helicopter so crews can obtain and record measurements from eight test station locations— see the attached map for location information. Each stop is expected to take 5 to 10 minutes on the ground to obtain the necessary readings. The proposed work within the Tsuut'ina Nation lands will take approximately 1-2 hours to complete. All work for this Project will take place on the existing right-of-way.

These activities are part of the ongoing pipeline integrity and maintenance program on the NGTL System, and are done to ensure the safe operation of the system.

NGTL has tentatively scheduled this work for the week of September 15, 2025. The specific day has yet to be determined by the pilot, weather conditions permitting.
