Heating and Home Maintenance

Dzinisi Guja Tsuut'ina Home Occupants,

As the cold season approaches, please take time to prepare your home for winter. Proper seasonal maintenance ensures your home stays warm, comfortable, and prevents costly issues with your heating system or plumbing.

Seasonal Home Maintenance Tips

Furnace Filter Replacement: Replace furnace filters regularly to keep your heating system working efficiently.

Windows & Doors: Check for drafts and seal any gaps to retain heat.

Thermostat Settings: Lower the temperature when you're not home or at night to save on heating bills.

Preventing Frozen Lines & Hose Bib Failure: As temperatures drop, please shut off and drain all outdoor hose bibs. Leaving hoses connected can cause pipes to freeze and burst, leading to water damage and costly repairs.

Do not water livestock with outside hoses during freezing weather. Doing so can also cause frozen or broken water lines.

If You Don't Have Heat make sure you check these before calling in;

1. **Check your thermostat:** Make sure it's set to Heat and the temperature is high enough to trigger your furnace. Change batteries in thermostat (dead batteries can cause no heat)
2. **Check your furnace:** Confirm it's powered on and no breakers or fuses are tripped.
3. **Emergency Measures:** If it's too cold, relocate to a family member's home until repairs are made.
