Subject: Update on Tsuut'ina Nation Water Litigation

We want to provide an important update regarding the Tsuut'ina Nation's Water Litigation Claim.

As shared during the Nation update on October 27, 2025, Canada recently notified us that they will no longer engage in discussions to settle our water claim. This decision affects not only Tsuut'ina Nation, but also several other First Nations who received similar letters of rejection.

Our community has been clear in its direction, we must take action.

On November 6, 2025, Acting Chief Andy Onespot met with Assembly of First Nations (AFN) National Chief Cindy Woodhouse Nepinak to seek the full backing of the AFN in addressing not only Tsuut'ina's water claim, but also the broader issue impacting other Nations.

During this meeting, Acting Chief Onespot asked the National Chief to demand on his behalf an audience with the Prime Minister of Canada, to ensure these claims are treated seriously and respectfully, as matters of treaty and inherent rights.

In addition to these political efforts, Tsuut'ina Nation continues to actively pursue action through the legal process, while also seeking support from other government agencies to strengthen our position and ensure accountability from Canada.

Furthermore, Acting Chief Onespot will meet with the Conservative Opposition on November 10, 2025, to gain further support and ensure that the rights of Tsuut'ina and all affected Nations are protected and respected across all levels of government.

The Nation remains fully committed to pursuing justice and fairness on this matter, and we will continue to keep citizens informed as developments occur.

We thank the community for its continued guidance, unity, and support as we move forward together.
