



WHAT IS THE TRESPASS BYLAW?

The Trespass Law allows for the removal and punishment of a person trespassing on the Tsuut'ina lands or premises. This Law was enacted and amended by Tsuut'ina Head Chief and Minor Chiefs on October 17 2025.

WHY SHOULD WE HAVE THIS LAW?

Provides a way to keep our community safe because we will be able to determine who can be on our Nation lands or premises.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

No person may trespass on Tsuut'ina lands or premises when that person has notice not to trespass.

WHAT HAS BEEN AMENDED?

A trespasser with notice not to trespass is guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding two thousand (\$2000) dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty (30) days, or both.

- 16. (a) A first offence in respect of a violation of any provision of this law shall be a fine of one thousand (\$1000) dollars;
- (b) A second offence in respect of a violation of any provision of this law shall be a fine of fifteen hundred (\$1500) dollars;
- (c) A third offence in respect of a violation of any provision of this law shall be a fine of two thousand (\$2000) dollars; and
- (d) A fourth offence in respect of a violation of any provision of this law shall be a fine of two thousand (\$2000) dollars and a thirty (30) day property seizure and impoundment.
