TSUU T'INA NATION REPEAL BY-LAW NO. 12.14.14.04.E

Dear Chief and Council:

I am pleased to inform you that the above-captioned by-law will come into force on March 25, 2014 pursuant to section 82 of the *Indian Act*. Upon having reviewed the repeal by-law, we have determined that we do not have any additional comments to provide.

Please note that if any comments were provided otherwise, these should not be treated as a legal opinion. They are intended as suggestions only, and neither the Minister nor the Department of Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada can guarantee that a by-law based upon them would be upheld in court. Only a court of competent jurisdiction has the power to rule on a by-law's validity. Furthermore, a submission of any by-law in accordance with our suggestions does not automatically ensure that the by-law will come into force. Any by-law submitted to our office must first be considered in its entirety.

Canada

By-laws made under the *Indian Act* are subject to the *Statutory Instruments Act*. As such, no person may be convicted of an offence for contravening an unpublished by-law unless the Band Council proves that the by-law is exempted from publication in the Canada Gazette and that reasonable steps were taken to bring the by-law to the attention of persons who may be affected by it. An individual has the right to inspect and obtain copies of by-laws.

Although not a requirement, we recommend that First Nations submit their by-laws to our office in draft form prior to enactment whenever possible. An initial review of the draft of a proposed by-law gives First Nations an opportunity to discuss it and also assists in avoiding any major difficulties prior to enactment.



Under the guidance of Almighty God, Our Creator, and as a sovereign Nation; We, the people of Tsuu T'ina Nation, in preservation and continuation of the Tsuu T'ina Nation's unique culture, identity, traditions, language and institutions, and with respect to the special relationship to the land and resources, in continued relationship with all First Nations and Canada; Do ordain and establish this law in accordance with our inherent right to governance.

Enacted on ~~January~~ of 2014 in Tsuu T'ina Nation
Coming Into Force Date:

WHEREAS the Chief and Council of Tsuu T'ina Nation under inherent sovereignty as a First Nation of Canada desires to enact a Legislation Repeal By Law within the jurisdiction of the Tsuu T'ina Nation Lands;

AND WHEREAS it is considered to be expedient and necessary for the benefit of the Tsuu T'ina Nation for credible governance to keep all Tsuu T'ina Nation By Laws current and practical.

AND WHEREAS the current listed enforceable Tsuu T'ina Bylaws that are outdated or inconsistent with present day situations is repealed.

NOW THEREFORE the Chief and Council of the Tsuu T'ina Nation hereby enacts the following Law:


Short Title: This law may be cited as the "Tsuu T'ina Legislation Repeal By Law".

WHEREAS CHIEF AND COUNCIL OF THE TSUU T'INA NATION HAS BEEN DULY ELECTED PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE INDIAN ACT AND IS EMPOWERED TO ACT ON BEHALF OF THE MEMBERS OF THE TSUU T'INA NATION;

WHEREAS CHIEF AND COUNCIL HAVE MET IN A QUORUM AT A DULY CONVENED CHIEF AND COUNCIL MEETING ON February 11 2014; AND

WHEREAS CHIEF AND COUNCIL IS ACTING ON ITS AUTHORITY WHICH IS DIRECTLY DERIVED FROM THE ELECTORATE OF THE TSUU T'INA NATION; AND

WHEREAS THE CHIEF AND COUNCIL OF TSUU T'INA NATION UNDER INHERENT SOVEREIGNTY AS A FIRST NATION OF CANADA DESIRES TO ENACT A LEGISLATION REPEAL BYLAW WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE TSUU T'INA NATION LANDS; AND

WHEREAS IT IS CONSIDERED TO BE EXPEDIENT AND NECESSARY FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE TSUU T'INA NATION FOR CREDIBLE GOVERNANCE TO KEEP ALL TSUU T'INA NATION BYLAWS CURRENT AND PRACTICAL; AND

WHEREAS THE CURRENT LISTED ENFORCEABLE TSUU T'INA BYLAWS THAT ARE OUTDATED OR INCONSISTENT WITH PRESENT DAY SITUATIONS IS REPEALED; AND

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CHIEF AND COUNCIL OF THE TSUU T'INA NATION HEREBY ENACTS THE FOLLOWING LAW:
