## Unauthorized Alberta Separatist Activity on Tsuut'ina Nation Lands

Tsuut'ina Nation Xàkújághá-yiná (leadership) is advising citizens and the public that unauthorized Alberta separatist groups set up information booths on Tsuut'ina Nation lands this past week without consent. These groups were immediately removed.

These incidents occurred in the Redwood Meadows area and the Costco commercial area. The presence of these groups caused concern within the Nation. Xàkújághá-yiná views any such activity as a direct challenge to the Nation's sovereignty and does not permit separatist booths, rallies, or related activities on Nation lands.

Xàkújághá-yiná have taken immediate and decisive action. The Mayor of Redwood Meadows, Tsuut'ina Nation Tosguna Police, and TAZA have all been formally notified and clearly directed that Alberta separatist groups are not permitted, under any circumstances, to set up on Tsuut'ina Nation lands. All parties have been instructed to remove these groups immediately should they attempt to return.

For your safety, Xàkújághá-yiná is asking citizens **not to engage** with these groups. Engagement increases the risk of confrontation and places Nation members in unsafe situations. If citizens observe any unauthorized activity of this nature, please **contact Tosguna Police directly at 403-271-3777** so the matter can be addressed safely and appropriately.

Tsuut'ina Nation remains firm in protecting its lands, its people, and its inherent rights, and appreciates the cooperation of citizens in maintaining safety and order within the Nation.
