TSUUT'INA CITIZEN NOTICE

July 17, 2026

To: Tsuut'ina Nation Citizens

Dada'nast'ada

On November 20, 2025, you elected a majority new Xakiji uwa Xakujaa yina and gave us a mandate of integrity, transparency, and accountability. We have not forgotten, and we will not.

I want you to hear from me directly, rather than general speculation and the media. You may have seen news reports about our former general counsel. This is because the Tsuut'ina Nation filed a Statement of Claim with the Court of King's Bench of Alberta. Our allegations are set out in that document, which is a matter of public record.

You have our word that we are restoring integrity and accountability, rebuilding trust, and safeguarding the future of our citizens. Where the Nation's interests have not been protected, we will act properly, on the record, and for as long as it takes. This is one step, not the end of the work. We will not look away.

Because this matter is before the courts, there is a limit to what I can say publicly for now, and I can't say more than that limit allows. That is not avoidance, this is how we protect the Nation's position and ensure this is done right. When we can share more information and as developments continue, we will be updating the Nation's citizens.

I ask for your patience, and I thank you for your trust.
