➤ **Tuesday, August 4 to August 26, 2026, Monday to Thursday, 9 to 3**

For Level 1, you will receive

- 45 hours (3 credits) post-secondary coursework related to child development
- High School CTS Courses CCCS 3110, 3120, 3130, 3140 and 3150 (offered through Career and Technology Studies at Alberta high schools)
- ELCC coursework with outcomes that focus on diversity and Indigenous learnings, as approved by Children's Services
- Receive support in finding a placement at a certified childcare provider location provincial certification.
- Upon Successful Completion of Level One Certification, you will qualify to register for Level Two starting in September 2026
- Job Coaching, Resume Writing, Interview Skills Employment counseling □ Resume preparation

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Early Childhood Educator Level Two Certification Courses Start September 8, 2026

If you have your Level One Credential this course is for you. Tsuut'ina Nation is partnered with Northern Lakes College to offer a condensed program over 25 weeks to gain your Level Two Certification from a public post-secondary institution.

The Early Learning and Child Care certificate program prepares you for a rewarding career working with children up to 12 years of age. Graduates will develop the skills to work with children who have exceptionalities. The course will be offered through video conferencing taking two separate courses a month.
