The ABTraceTogether App

Enhances manual contact tracing and capacity, and facilitates early detection. It means Albertans will be contacted more quickly if they are at risk. Use of the app is voluntary; users must opt in.

The app does not track the user's physical location and does not use GPS. Protecting privacy is paramount; all contact data is only on the user's phone and is deleted after 21 days. Secure contact tracing is a cornerstone of Alberta's

Relaunch Strategy.

The Constitution has been in development through the Legislative Process for the past 5 years in Part One of drafting and development.

The Constitution is a "Stream A" document, as per Part 2A-New Document of the Legislative Process Act. Citizen readings are will be conducted and Chief and Council will be reviewing feedback and approving amendments to the following documents.

- Draft Constitution
- Draft Declaration

The L.P.T.S department is now moving forward with PHASE 3 of our Tsuut'ina Nation Constitution Workplan, the 'Community Engagement' Phase.

We will be having the first readings online, on the following dates:

- Wednesday August 5th, 12th & 19th, 2020

Tsuut'ina Nation CONSTITUTION GUIDE



It is the intent of this document to guide all Tsuut'ina Nation Citizens through the Tsuut'ina Nation Constitution in an easy to understand way. Comprehension is as equally important as the document itself.

Article I. Tsuut'ina Statement to define how we, as a collective, shall be referred to as the "Tsuut'ina Nation".

Article II. Tsuut'ina Language Stating our rights to use, promote and speak our language.

Article III. Official Seal and Emblem The seal is the official image that is used only on Legislation that is enacted within Tsuut'ina Nation.

Article IV. Jurisdiction The area identified and known as "Tsuut'ina Nation". The Tsuut'ina Nation Citizens shall decide and determine how jurisdiction is exercised in and on our land.

Article V. Duty to Defend We will take the necessary (peaceful) actions to defend this Constitution and inherent rights.

Article VI. Citizen and Individual Rights and Freedoms

Governing Power: As Tsuut'ina Citizens with an operational system of government, are capable of taking part in our government system.

Leadership Selection: With a democratic election process, we are able to vote our in our leadership.

Protection and Due Process of Law: Citizens shall have equal access to and protection. Tsuut'ina Government shall not deny any citizen equal protection of its laws or deprive any citizen of Freedom or property, without due process.

Fundamental individual and Citizen Rights: Human rights, Inherent rights, Treaty rights, and freedoms recognized by International law are inherent to all Tsuut'ina Nation Citizens and can include:

1. Personal freedoms such as religious practice, thought, belief, opinion, association etc.;
2. Utilize Tsuut'ina Nation Culture and Traditions in legal processes;
3. Peacefully gather;
4. Vote without bullying, pressure or bribes;
5. Reside on the Nation so long as the Citizen is in good standing with the Laws;
6. Share in distributions;
7. Right to participate as a TN citizen and a Canadian Citizen, use other domestic legislation as long as it does not harm the collective rights; and
8. Rights are the same to citizens living off reserve.

Article VII. Tsuut'ina Collective Rights

1. Govern and determine; Including the right to develop, change our Constitution, laws and governance;
2. Establish and maintain our own government, political status and government institutions;
3. Decide citizenship, right to control the use of lands, water, air and natural resources;
4. Enter in Treaty and any other agreements with any other governments;
5. Consultation for transparent use of resources and economic revenue held in trust; and
6. Practice and promote Tsuut'ina way of life and traditional ceremony.

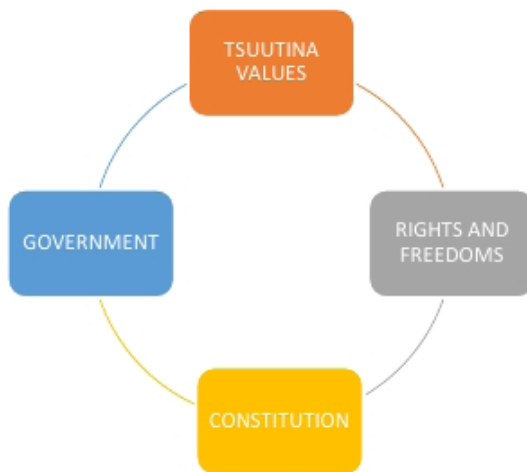

Article VIII. Governing Authority Elected leadership are the governing authority under the laws given to us by the Creator, and are responsible for maintaining and preservation of our sovereign rights and

freedoms. Leadership is governed by this Constitution and all other applicable laws and policy. Powers not delegated to leadership remain the collective authority of Tsuut'ina Citizens.

Article IX. Government Branches Governing Framework, and activated by Governing and Administrative authority. The four authorities under the Constitution are Legislative, Administration, Economic and Judiciary.

Article X. Legislative Branch Responsible for:

1. Intergovernmental Representation, Working with International, National & local governments;
2. Ratifying, updating and legislation and policy;
3. Setting and overseeing mandates through collaborative

Legislative Authority is the Tsuut'ina Nation Chief and Council and they are responsible to enact and ratify laws.

Delegated Authority is assigned by Tsuut'ina Nation Chief and Council through specific legislation, tripartite, funding agreements and terms of reference. Delegated Authorities are established through Tribunals, Commission, Boards, and Committees.

Article XI. Administrative Branch **Responsible for:** In compliance with applicable Laws and policy; which carries out day to day administrative processes including service for language, culture, social well being, community, lands and governance obligations.

Article XII. Economic Branch **Responsible for:** Upholding Tsuut'ina Business Charter for Tsuut'ina Nation economic growth. Oversees companies established to provide revenue for the nation.

Article XIII. Judicial Branch (Will be) **Responsible for:** Upholding the Tsuut'ina Nation Legislation, with the assistance of Tosguna (if needed) though traditional Tsuut'ina Cultural practices and court system that has jurisdiction over the Legislation.

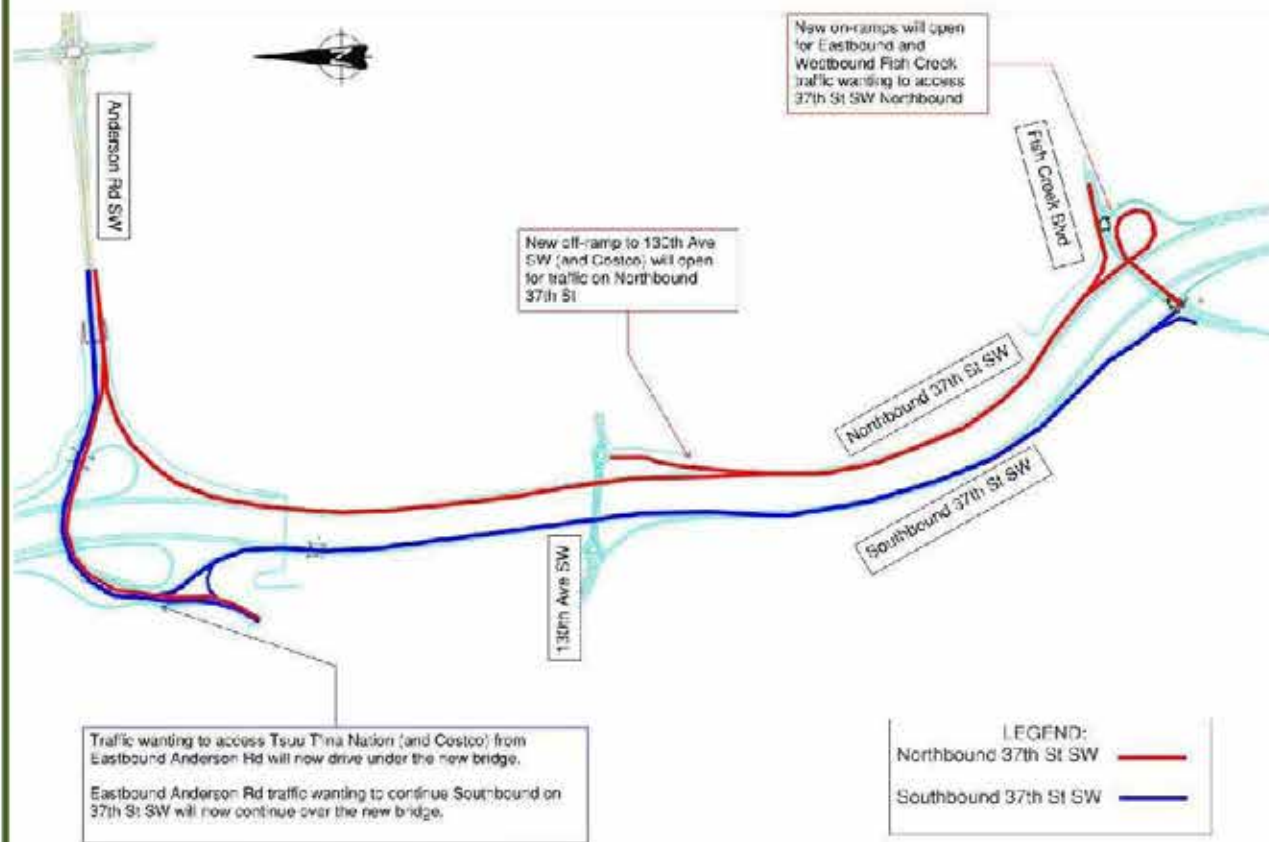

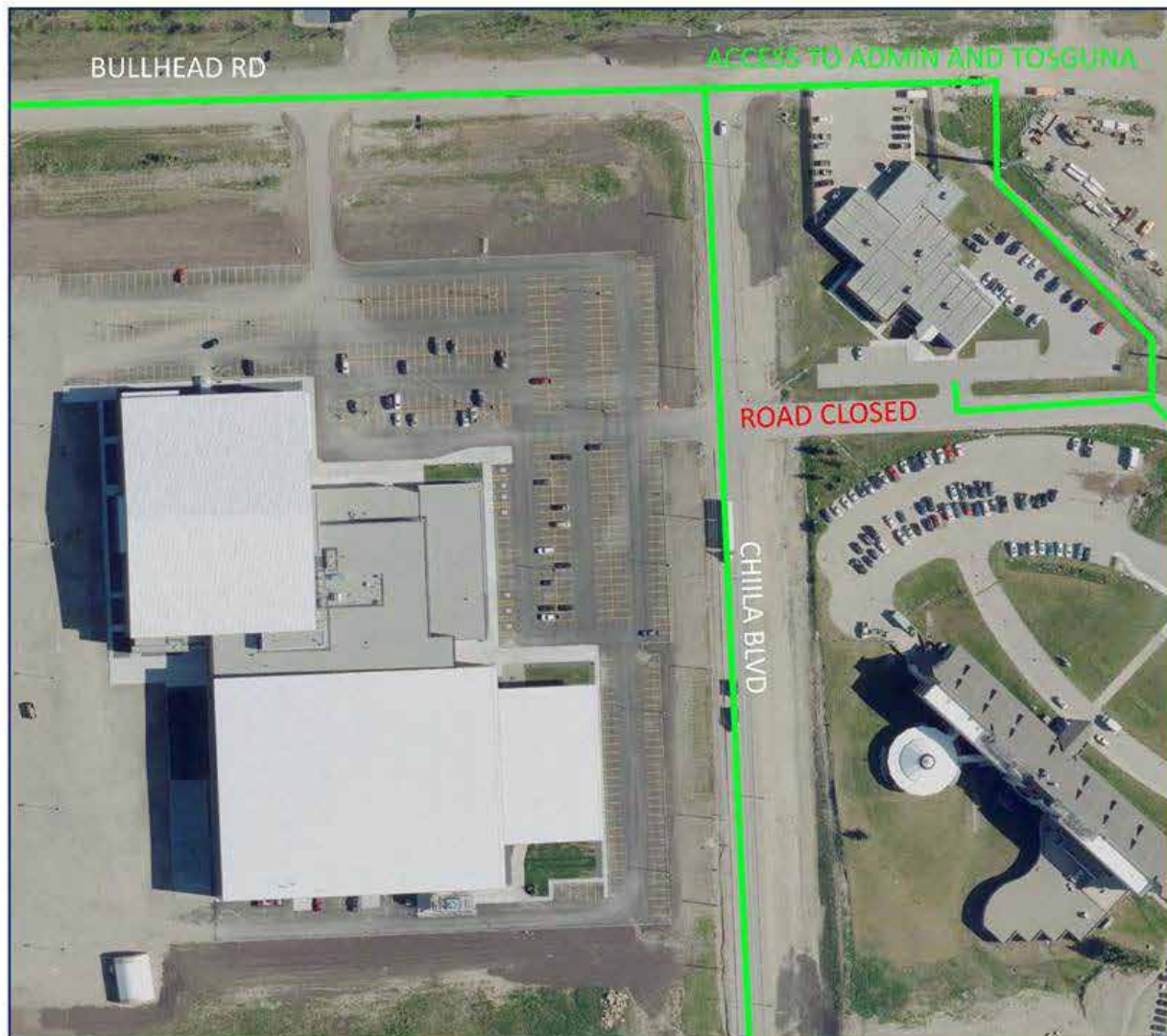
