

When voting, you must show identification to prove your name and your current residential address.

Choose from one of the three ID options:

- 1** Present your **Alberta Driver's Licence** or **Alberta Identification Card** with your name and current residential address.
- 2** Show **two pieces of identification**, both with your name and with one piece showing your current residential address, from the list below:

- 3** Your identity and residential address may also be established using an **Attestation Form**. Attestations forms are signed by a person in a position of authority and are available for the following:

- Incarcerated Elector
- Student Elector In Residence
- Elector Living on Reserve or Settlement
- Tenant Elector
- Elector Receiving Services from Shelter or Community Support Centre
- Elector in Supportive Living or Continuing Care
- Elector on Mennonite or Hutterite Colony
