



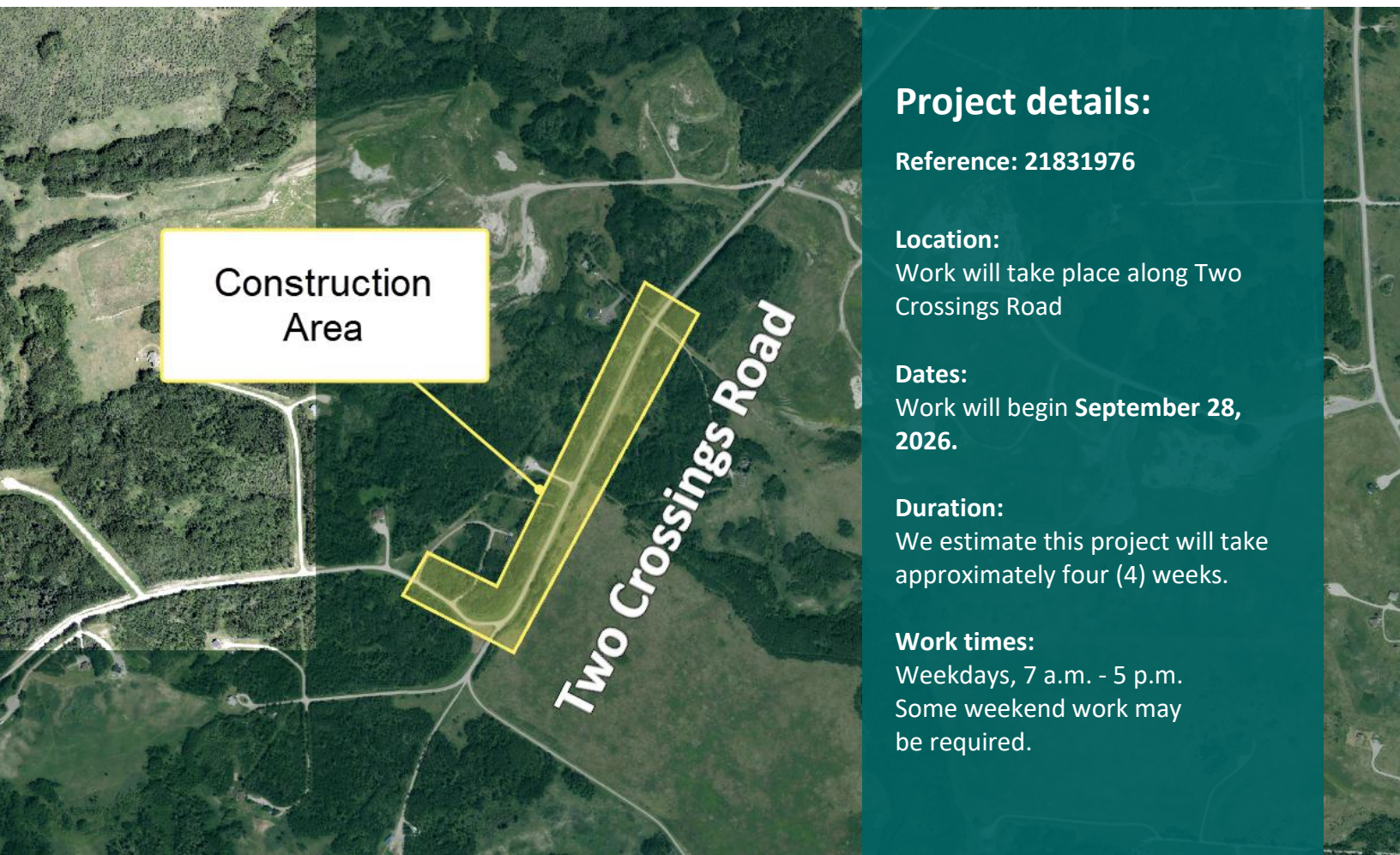
CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

We estimate this project will take approximately four (4) weeks.

Weekdays, 7 a.m. - 5 p.m.
Some weekend work may be required.

What's happening?

ENMAX Power is upgrading the electrical services in your area. We are replacing several kilometres of existing overhead distribution lines to support Tsuut'ina Nation's evolving electrical needs. We will also be replacing some of the existing power poles and anchor supports.

If you are a Property Manager for a building affected by this work, please share this notice with your tenants.



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What to expect:

We make every effort to minimize the effect our work has on daily activities, and we follow all applicable standards and bylaws. Below are the things to be aware of related to this project.

During construction:

- ENMAX and contractor vehicles, bucket trucks and associated utility equipment will be onsite.
- Project and/or road signage.
- Noise and/or minor vibrations during construction.
- Trees growing too close to overhead power lines will be trimmed for safety.
- Please ensure that pets are on a leash or are safely secured during work hours.
- **Access to fenced yards or property may be required.** If you have concerns with crews entering your property, please contact our Customer Experience Team at 403-514-3990.

Power outages:

- A power outage will be required for this project on October 15, 2026.
- **If your address is impacted, you'll receive a separate notice in advance** outlining important outage information.

Road closures, detours, parking and access:

- There will be temporary rolling lane closures along Two Crossings Road during the project. Please follow all signs and detours.
- Residents will have access to homes throughout the duration of work.
- **Please ensure the area surrounding utility equipment (power poles, anchors, etc.) is clear of obstructions.**

After construction:

- Areas affected by the project will be repaired once work is complete (weather permitting).
- Ongoing maintenance of repaired areas on private property is the responsibility of the homeowner/property manager.
